

## Things to do Before Starting Classes

Contact your advisor or graduate coordinator if you have questions about course registration.

Review information on registering for the <u>student health insurance plan</u> and decide if you want to enroll in the plan. International students are required to enroll in the university's student health insurance plan or to enroll in a plan with comparable coverage, <u>review more details on this policy</u>.

Review the information on the <u>immunization requirement</u> and submit records of immunization via Med+Proctor. Please note requirements vary depending on whether you are an international or domestic student and which campus you are attending.

For students commuting to campus, make sure to purchase your <u>parking pass</u>. Passes go on sale for graduate students on November 27.

Sign up for <u>Flash ALERTS texts</u> to receive important notifications, critical news, and information regarding campus emergencies or instant safety updates.

For students who are beginning a graduate assistantship appointment, make sure to <u>review this</u> <u>information from Academic Personnel</u> on completing your hiring documents and scheduling an appointment to process paperwork for your GA position.

Obtain a <u>FLASHcard</u>, which can be used to check out materials from the library, access university facilities, and more. Students can apply for a FLASHCARD before coming to campus. You may also have time to get one on the day of GSO. <u>See instructions</u> on how to apply in advance of attending GSO.
