About the Mental Health Resource & Referral Guide

In 2023 Kent State University's Center for Public Policy and Health, in the College of Public Health, was awarded \$600,000 in grant funding by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration to support the Northeast Ohio Mental Health Awareness Training (NEO MHAT) project. This is a collaborative project with the Educational Service Center of Northeast Ohio; Stark County Educational Service Center; Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board of Cuyahoga County; and Stark County Mental Health and Addiction Recovery. The project spans 69 school districts in nine counties in Northeast Ohio. Using evidence-based mental health awareness trainings and community resource education, NEO MHAT trains teachers and relevant school personnel to connect children and youth to appropriate mental health resources. This guide was developed to assist those participating in NEO MHAT with identifying mental health resources.

Some resources may offer telehealth. Call any resource you are interested in to determine what resource is best for you and your situation.

This resource guide highlights only some resources, it is not intended to be an inclusive list. Contact your local Alcohol, Drug, and Mental Health Board (ADHAM) Board for more resources.

Things to consider when giving a referral:

- 1. Remain calm.
- 2. Ask the person what referrals they are comfortable with and what they would be most interested in.
- 3. Assess the situation. If the situation turns into a crisis or the person is in danger of hurting themselves or others, call 911 immediately.
- 4. Avoid giving advice and be non-judgemental. Put yourself in their shoes and allow them to be in charge of their own path to recovery.
