To be admitted to the Nursing for Registered Nurses major, students must show evidence of having met the following requirements:

- Evidence of graduation in good standing from a state-approved associate degree nursing program
- Minimum 2.00 (on a 4.0 scale) overall GPA
- Active, unrestricted registered nurse (RN) license in the state in which practica will be completed
- Completion of required science courses or their direct equivalents with a cumulative 2.0 GPA
 - Anatomy and Physiology: BSCI 21010 and BSCI 21020
 - Chemistry: CHEM 10055 or CHEM 10050 or CHEM 10060
 - Microbiology: BSCI 20021

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Requirements to graduate with the BSN degree program: To graduate, students must have minimum 120 credits hours, 39 upper-division credits hours of coursework, a minimum 2.0 major GPA and minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA. They must also fulfill an approved experiential learning experience, a two-course diversity requirement (domestic and global), complete a writing intensive course with a minimum C (2.000) grade. More specific graduation requirement information can be found in the Academic Policies section of the Kent State University Catalog (www.kent.edu/catalog).

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It is recommended that students intending to pursue the BSN in Nursing for Registered Nurses through Kent State University consult with academic advisors at both Lorain County Community College and Kent State University.
