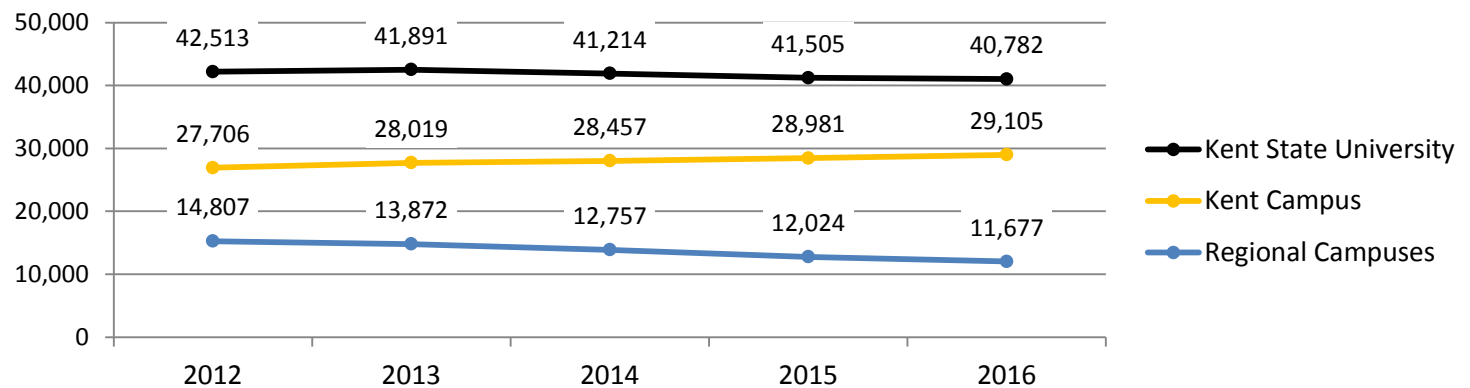
## Student Enrollments
