## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Kent State University 8-Campus-System enrollment for the Fall 11 Term. The Kent State University 8-Campus-System experienced a 1.98% increase in unduplicated student headcount; 42,185 students in Fall 11 compared to 41,365 students in Fall 10 for a net increase of 820 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 1.81% (650 students) and graduate enrollment increased by 3.09% (170 students).

Student FTE increase by 3.09%; the Kent State University 8-Campus-System generated 1,022.60 more FTE compared to Fall 10. Undergraduate FTE increased by 3.00% (902.40 FTE) and graduate FTE increased by 4.07% (120.20 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 12.74 compared to 12.60 in Fall 10. Graduate MUL is 8.14 compared to last year's 8.06 and the campus MUL is 12.12 compared to 11.99 last year.

Note: During Spring and Fall terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 15; during Summer terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 30.

**Preponderant Headcount:**

This method of calculating enrollment is based upon where the student has the majority of his or her classes. For example, if a student has six hours at the Kent Campus and three hours at the Stark Campus, the student would be counted only at the Kent Campus. In the event that a student has an equal number of hours at any of the campuses, the campus at which the student registered first is considered the student's home campus.
