- Maybe on-line or face to face sessions, give stipends? Pracs= \$100/others =0
- KAPEP recommended doing student teaching seminar on sites. What happened with this? Ask Bette Brooks, where is KAPEP? Who could do this – Jerry Brodsky?

- Develop common matrix of all the field experience assessments of programs?
- Look at 3.2 elementary matrix and then develop a data matrix from the assessments.
- Simple survey of TC's about their field experiences?

- CT orientations needed to recruit new teachers.

- Will CT's do all this without more compensation or professional development?
- Student teaching \$18 week stipend or \$35 week tuition waiver + library privileges.
- Give ID to library beyond student teaching semester.
- Get principals/superintendents/assistant superintendents expectations of student teaching/field experience thru KAPEP.
