## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Kent Campus enrollment for the Fall 13 Term. The Kent Campus experienced a 1.38% increase in student headcount; 28,998 students in Fall 13 compared to 28,602 students in Fall 12 for a net increase of 396 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 2.37% (532 students) and graduate enrollment decreased by 2.21% (-136 students).

Student FTE decrease by 0.44%; the Kent Campus generated 104.07 less FTE compared to Fall 12. Undergraduate FTE increased by 0.00% (0.60 FTE) and graduate FTE decreased by 2.80% (-104.66 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 13.11 compared to 13.42 in Fall 12. Graduate MUL is 9.02 compared to last year's 9.08 and the campus MUL is 12.26 compared to 12.48 last year.
