## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Kent Campus enrollment for the Spring 13 Term. The Kent Campus experienced a 2.85% increase in student headcount; 27,429 students in Spring 13 compared to 26,668 students in Spring 12 for a net increase of 761 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 1.35% (285 students) and graduate enrollment increased by 8.50% (476 students).

Student FTE increase by 2.00%; the Kent Campus generated 432.67 more FTE compared to Spring 12. Undergraduate FTE decreased by 1.03% (-193.20 FTE) and graduate FTE increased by 21.21% (625.86 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 13.02 compared to 13.33 in Spring 12. Graduate MUL is 8.83 compared to last year's 7.90 and the campus MUL is 12.09 compared to 12.19 last year.

Note: During Spring and Fall terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 15; during Summer terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 30.
