1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Kent Campus enrollment for the Summer I&II 11 Term. The Kent Campus experienced a 4.87% increase in student headcount; 8,484 students in Summer I&II 11 compared to 8,090 students in Summer I&II 10 for a net increase of 394 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 8.47% (426 students) and graduate enrollment decreased by 1.05% (-32 students).

Student FTE increase by 5.95%; the Kent Campus generated 82.26 more FTE compared to Summer I&II 10. Undergraduate FTE increased by 9.67% (78.43 FTE) and graduate FTE increased by 0.67% (3.83 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 2.44 compared to 2.42 in Summer I&II 10. Graduate MUL is 2.85 compared to last year's 2.80 and the campus MUL is 2.59 compared to 2.56 last year.

Note: During Spring and Fall terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 15; during Summer terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 30.
