## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Kent Campus enrollment for the Summer III 12 Term. The Kent Campus experienced a 2.40% increase in student headcount; 4,606 students in Summer III 12 compared to 4,498 students in Summer III 11 for a net increase of 108 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 1.90% (57 students) and graduate enrollment increased by 3.42% (51 students).

Student FTE increase by 2.84%; the Kent Campus generated 16.68 more FTE compared to Summer III 11. Undergraduate FTE increased by 6.63% (24.45 FTE) and graduate FTE decreased by 3.57% (-7.77 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 1.93 compared to 1.84 in Summer III 11. Graduate MUL is 2.04 compared to last year's 2.19 and the campus MUL is 1.96 compared to 1.96 last year.

Note: During Spring and Fall terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 15; during Summer terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 30.
