## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Kent Campus enrollment for the Summer III 13 Term. The Kent Campus experienced a 9.81% decrease in student headcount; 4,154 students in Summer III 13 compared to 4,606 students in Summer III 12 for a net decrease of 452 students. Undergraduate enrollment decreased by 7.21% (-221 students) and graduate enrollment decreased by 14.98% (-231 students).

Student FTE decrease by 12.10%; the Kent Campus generated 72.95 less FTE compared to Summer III 12. Undergraduate FTE decreased by 7.63% (-30.02 FTE) and graduate FTE decreased by 20.48% (-42.93 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 1.92 compared to 1.93 in Summer III 12. Graduate MUL is 1.91 compared to last year's 2.04 and the campus MUL is 1.91 compared to 1.96 last year.

Note: During Spring and Fall terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 15; during Summer terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 30.
