ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

- The student must have held membership in the Honors College for at least one semester prior to the CPA and have completed at least one all-Honors class.
- Only upper-division, letter-graded KSU classes may be used with the CPA.
- Students may complete only one CPA per semester and a maximum of 6-credit-hours of CPA per undergraduate degree.
- The CPA cannot be used with online classes.
- The CPA cannot be used for a class section already offered as Honors in that current term.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- Discuss the CPA option during regular Honors academic advising prior to submitting a contract.
- In consultation with the instructor, create a proposal (approximately 500 words) describing the Honors component of the class and attach it to this form.
- Attach the current non-Honors syllabus. – *The Honors College will request the new syllabus.*

INSTRUCTOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist the student in creating a learning experience that is richer and more sophisticated than the non-Honors section. Students should have the opportunity for in-depth research, field work, collaboration, presentation, or leadership.
- Ensure the project(s) the student wishes to complete is an appropriate addition to the existing course expectations.
- Update your blackboard sections (*see back of document for instructions*)
- Sign both the front of this form and the attached proposal.
- If appropriate, meet with the student outside of scheduled class time to review and discuss progress.

BLACKBOARD INSTRUCTIONS

If you have multiple sections of the same course, including an Honors and Non-Honors section, you may request they be **Combined** (or merged). It is recommended to request this prior to the start of the semester because information may be lost during the combination process. Although existing *content* could be exported and imported, any student *activity* (such as submissions, discussion board posts, grades) cannot be recovered, so please be sure to request the combine as soon as possible.

Once the courses are combined, you will see the new “master (combined) course” in your course list. Course materials can then be added and updated in a single location, and all activity will occur in this master (combined) course.

The students will automatically/seamlessly be redirected from the unavailable “child course sections” to the new master (combined) course.
