1. A minimum cumulative 2.75 GPA is required for admission to advanced study. A 3.0 GPA required in major in order to student teach and graduate.
2. A minimum of 120 valid hours are required for graduation from Kent State University.

4. Students must achieve a SLPI rating of Intermediate level or above in order to student teach and to graduate.
5. Qualifying scores on OAE: Assessment of Professional Knowledge–Multi-Age (PK-12) Pedagogy Assessment and the Special Education Specialist – Deaf/Hard of Hearing Content Assessments are required for Ohio Licensure.
