REQUIREMENTS

***An incomplete application will not be considered. Failure to follow directions will disqualify you. We will NOT contact you if you are missing required information or if you have not followed directions.**

1. IN DATE ORDER (include the date: month and year) submit a typed listing of extracurricular activities, community service, leadership awards and scholarships with the most recent listed first (college only past and present). **DO NOT** use a resume for your submission **and DO NOT include high school activities**. Also, for each extracurricular activity or service, please indicate the leadership position you held or that you were only a member.
2. Submit an **official** KSU transcript.
3. If you have attended other colleges/universities including those you attended for College Credit Plus or Post-Secondary, you **MUST** submit official transcripts from those institutions.

Please note: Not all scholarships require a FAFSA. However, it is advised that you complete an annual FAFSA because many scholarships require financial need be determined by the FAFSA. By not completing a FAFSA, you may be disqualified from consideration for some scholarships.
