

# **SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION**

**APPLICATION DEADLINE: Friday, February 22, 2019  
(For the academic year 2019–20)**

The scholarships that are available through the DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICAL SCIENCES are the Cummins Scholarship, the Bill and Linda Gainer Scholarship, the Harshbarger Scholarship, and the Math Club Scholarship. The eligibility requirements for the scholarships are listed below.

## **Cummins Scholarship**

In order to be eligible for this award, the applicant must be a mathematics, actuarial mathematics, applied mathematics or an integrated mathematics major with junior standing (i.e., at least 60 semester hours earned) at Kent State University. The amount of this award is variable.

## **Bill and Linda Gainer Scholarship in Mathematics**

Recipient must be a first generation undergraduate college student who is at least a Sophomore, majoring in mathematics, actuarial mathematics, or applied mathematics with a 3.0 or higher GPA who is Pell Grant eligible.

## **Harshbarger Scholarship**

In order to be eligible for this award, the applicant must be a mathematics, actuarial mathematics, or applied mathematics major at Kent State University. The applicant must have also completed Math 12003 (Calculus II), Math 21001 (Linear Algebra), and either Math 22005 (Calculus III) or an upper-division mathematics course. The amount of this award is variable.

## **Math Club Scholarship**

The recipient of this scholarship must be a mathematics, actuarial mathematics, applied mathematics, or integrated mathematics major in good standing at Kent State University. Special consideration will be given to students who have demonstrated leadership at KSU or in their communities. Students early in their academic career are especially encouraged to apply for this Scholarship. The amount of this award is variable.
