## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Trumbull Campus enrollment for the Spring 11 Term. The Trumbull Campus experienced a 9.76% increase in student headcount; 3047 students in Spring 11 compared to 2776 students in Spring 10 for a net increase of 271 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 9.73% (270 students) and graduate enrollment increased by 50% (1 student).

Student FTE increase by 2.69%; the Trumbull Campus generated 44.80 more FTE compared to Spring 10. Undergraduate FTE increased by 2.68% (44.60 FTE) and graduate FTE increased by 42.55% (0.20 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 8.43 compared to 9.01 in Spring 10. Graduate MUL is 3.33 compared to last year's 3.50 and the campus MUL is 8.43 compared to 9.01 last year.

Note: During Spring and Fall terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 15; during Summer terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 30.
