## 1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Tuscarawas Campus enrollment for the Spring 10 Term. The Tuscarawas Campus experienced a 20.01% increase in student headcount; 2387 students in Spring 10 compared to 1989 students in Spring 09 for a net increase of 398 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 20.32% (403 students) and graduate enrollment decreased by 83.33% (-5 students).

Student FTE increase by 22.35%; the Tuscarawas Campus generated 280.66 more FTE compared to Spring 09. Undergraduate FTE increased by 22.45% (281.66 FTE) and graduate FTE decreased by 83.33% (-1.0 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 9.66 compared to 9.49 in Spring 09. Graduate MUL is 3.0 compared to last year's 3.0 and the campus MUL is 9.65 compared to 9.47 last year.
