

# Embed a Kaltura Video in Blackboard

If you want to share your Kaltura videos in your Blackboard courses, you can use the Kaltura Media tool to embed the videos so students can view them right within the course.

## 1. Access your course

### 1.1 Log into Blackboard

Log into Blackboard Learn at <https://learn.kent.edu> or through Flashline.

### 1.2 Enter your course

Click on the name of your course to access it.

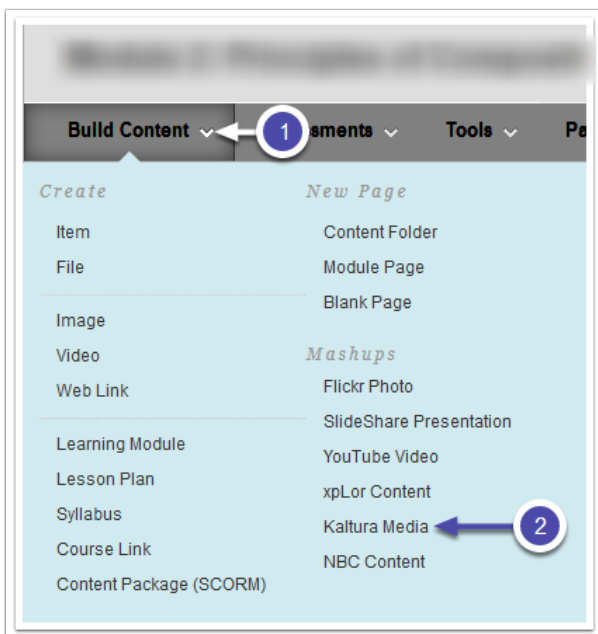
## 2. Embed a Kaltura video

### 2.1 Navigate to a content area or folder

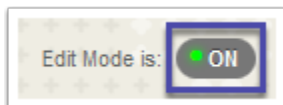
Navigate to the content area or folder in which you want to embed the video.

### 2.2 Access the Kaltura Media mashup

Click on the **Build Content** button in the Action Bar across the top of the Grade Center. Then select **Kaltura Media** from the drop-down menu.



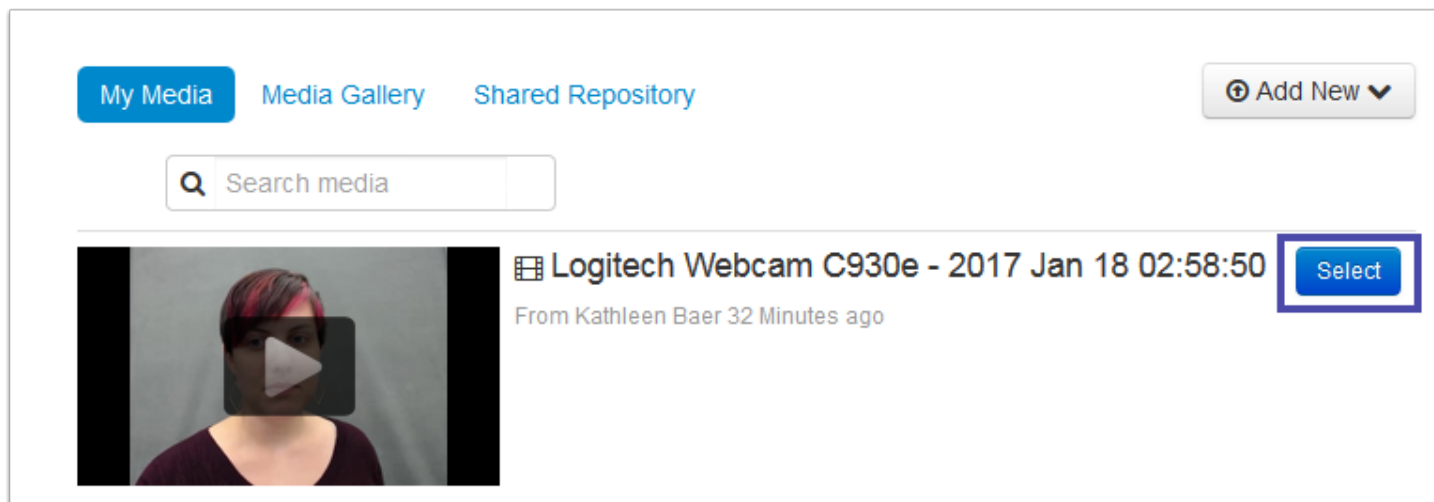
**Note:** If the Action Bar does not appear at the top of the page, make sure that Edit Mode is turned ON (toggle button in the upper right corner).



## 2.3 Select your video

You will see a gallery of your Kaltura videos. Locate the video you want to embed and click the **Select** button.

Note: You can use the **search media bar** to more quickly locate videos.



## 2.4 Set video options

- a. Enter a **title** for the video link.
- b. Enter a **description** for the video link.
- c. Attach supporting **files or documents**.
- d. Set **standard options**, including show/hide, track statistics, and date and time restrictions
