Essential Job Responsibilities:

- Accompany environmental health specialist and/or other officials to observe application of appropriate environmental health methods and procedures on surveys and investigations of unsanitary matters to gain expertise in environmental health testing, sampling principles and techniques, in order to perform environmental health and sanitation inspections on various premises, facilities and environmental health systems.
- Perform routine environmental health testing to determine non-compliance with unsanitary abatement standards and apply agency's standardized methodology to enforce state and local laws and regulations for conditions.
- Collect water and effluent samples in accordance with standard methods; conduct investigations of safety hazards; perform operational permit inspections to ensure and enforce compliance with applicable state and local environmental health standards.
- Review plans and give technical advice to owners, operators and contractors on laws, rules and procedures in various health fields.
- Write reports evaluating training progress periodically, throughout training period.
- Perform other tasks of public health importance as requested or assigned by the Director/Unit Manager of Environmental Health Services and/or Health Commissioner.
