1. ATTEND A MANDATORY MUSIC PLACEMENT & AUDITION DAY

MUSIC THEORY PLACEMENT ASSESSMENT

This test will be given during your Music Placement & Audition Day. The 30-minute theory placement test is used to place students into a music theory section with students of similar musical ability and background. The placement will assess your knowledge of note reading, major and minor (natural, harmonic, melodic) scales, major and minor key signatures, meter and rhythm, intervals and triads.
