Videos center around community leaders in various sectors. After each short video is watched, there is a supplemental worksheet that you can complete with your students if time is available.

After watching the first video, you will have the students text 330-520-2504 to register for scholarship drawings. Each student will only be eligible to register once.

Leaders of Tomorrow will be awarding eight \$250 scholarships to be used at the school of the student's choice. Kent State will be awarding eight \$500 scholarships to be used at Kent State University at Tuscarawas.

#### **Natalie Bollon**

Natalie Bollon is the Director of the Alcohol, Drug Addiction, Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Board of Tuscarawas and Carroll Counties. Prior to serving in the role of Director, Natalie served as the Manager of Community Services at the Board. In the 13 years that she's been employed by ADAMHS Board, Natalie has worked collaboratively with community partners to develop multiple resources to impact the opiate epidemic, provide support for adults with mental illness, and impact the lives of our children. After attaining her graduate degree from Purdue University, Natalie began her career as a counselor and supervisor at a local agency.



#### Sarah Dugger

Sarah Dugger is a textile designer, fine artist and muralist. She started her career in the commercial textile industry for both fashion and home furnishings in New York City and San Francisco. Her fine art paintings are exhibited in galleries and art museums across the nation. She is also a member of the Wall Dogs, an international group of muralists who paint large scale, outdoor murals. Sarah is currently designing and printing textile yardage in her studio, Sarah Dugger Hand Printed Textiles.



#### **Rocky Shanower**

Rocky Shanower is the co-owner & founder of Park Street Pizza and mobile wood-fired pizza concept named Bahler Street. He and his partner/wife Courtney Shanower opened Park Street Pizza in 2003 at the age of 22 years old in their hometown of Sugarcreek, Ohio. They have two sons named Rigsby (12) and Wilde (8). Park Street Pizza has become a regional destination known for a locally sourced seasonal menu. Bahler Street is a mobile wood-fired pizza concept that was developed in early 2014 by the couple, pairing Courtney's sourdough recipe with Rocky's concept of a mobile pizza truck. His passions in business include collaborating and developing relationships with local farmers and producers, team building with an emphasis on service and culture, and obsessing over new opportunities for growth in the service and hospitality industry. Rocky is a college dropout who was named 2020 Young Entrepreneur of Year by Pizza Today magazine.

#### **Tiffany Foxx**

Tiffany is a positive, compassionate, and energetic leader with a heart for service and helping others. She believes strongly in doing all she can to help meet the needs of the underserved and underprivileged. She earned a Bachelor of Science in Healthcare Management from Franklin University and a Master of Science in Organizational Leadership from Springfield College. She began her professional career with the Massillon YMCA in February of 2006 where she served as program director and in July of 2007 was promoted to the executive director. In January of 2010, Tiffany and her family relocated to join the YMCA of Greater Dayton as executive director of the Xenia YMCA. In November of 2014, she received a promotion and became the executive director of the Huber Heights YMCA. In June of 2017, she became the CEO of the Tuscarawas County YMCA in Dover, Ohio where she and her family now reside.



#### **Orvis Campbell**

Orvis Campbell is proudly serving his second term as sheriff of Tuscarawas County. Sheriff Campbell began his service to the County in 1990 as a probation officer for Tuscarawas County Juvenile Court Judge George J. Demis. In 1994, Campbell was hired as a Deputy Sheriff and was promoted to Detective in 1997, and then worked his way up through several ranks as an investigator before being elected Sheriff in November of 2016. He also is an instructor for the Ohio Peace Officers Training Academy and is a member of the International Homicide Investigators Association, and a graduate of the 256th session of the FBI National Academy in Quantico, Virginia. Campbell is active in the community as a member of the Tuscarawas County Anti-Drug Coalition and a board member for United Way of Tuscarawas County. Sheriff Campbell is a proud supporter and member of the Tuscarawas County Farm Bureau. He is a former board member for Harbor House, the county's domestic violence shelter and substance abuse halfway house for women, and Personal and Family Counseling Services as well as the ADAMHS Board of Tuscarawas and Carroll Counties. Sheriff Campbell was proudly voted Ohio's outstanding Law Enforcement Officer for 2018 by the Ohio Prosecuting Attorney's Association. Campbell is a lifelong resident of Tuscarawas County, he and his wife Michelle have four children.
