

Encryption

Out of Scope: Any machine that is:

- in a lab or classroom and utilizes Deep Freeze or similar software,
- attached to specialized equipment,
- for which there isn't an Encryption, AD or Altiris solution.

Examples:

- Computers exempted through official process (See form)
- Computer with Deep Freeze and no thaw space
- Loaner computers that aren't assigned to an individual
- Linux Computers
- Macs (Solution coming soon)
- Systems with a RAID drive
- Dual Boot systems that can't be moved to a virtual machine
- Computers associated with Kent State campuses not in the US (Florence, China, etc)
- Computers going to Cuba, Iran, Iraq, North Korea, Sudan, and Syria - Re-encrypt upon return
